

What kind of program is this? It is an arts integrated with physical education multi-dimensional learning program. It is a program designed for any group of students (ages 5-15 years old), in SCHOOLS, SUMMER CAMPS, AFTERCARE OR REMEDIAL PROGRAMS, CHURCH GROUPS, RECREATION CENTERS, HOMESCHOOL GROUPS, etc.

How does it work: This approach builds a unique platform for balanced growth through intellectual, emotional, social, and physical grounding and functioning. By using physical activities combined with arts and crafts, music, dance, and theatre, we activate the base from which all learning arises. The Learning Pod, a more traditional learning setting, combines teacher-assisted student work with more student independent, self-monitored work. With increasing technology skills and by using computer-assisted learning, students become more responsible for their own learning.

How is it available: The Arts & Motion Program is available as a Summer Program or Afterschool Program, (either version can be used as a remedial program such as Title I; the Learning Pod can target review work). This program can be purchased also as an Enrichment Program for Gifted and Talented students (1 semester-12 weeks or 2 semesters- 24 weeks). Training is required for each version.



It is also one of our objectives that our students and families adopt good nutrition, healthy eating and physical activity for sustaining healthy weights, preventing obesity, and reducing risk factors for obesity-related chronic diseases. Community resources are being made available to support health initiatives and resources for parents and students.
