What kind of program is this? It is an arts integrated with physical education multi-dimensional learning program. It is a program designed for any group of students(ages 5-15 years old), AND SUMMER CAMPS, AFTERCARE OR REMEDIAL PROGRAMS, RECREATION CENTERS, CHURCH GROUPS, HOMESCHOOL GROUPS, etc. This is a research-based arts integration program and has been tested in 3 pilot programs over 2 settings private parochial and a public community center.

How does it work: This approach builds a unique platform for balanced growth through intellectual, emotional, social, and physical grounding and functioning. By using physical activities combined with arts and crafts. music, dance, and theatre, we activate the base from which all learning arises. The Learning Pod, a more traditional learning setting, combines teacherassisted student work with more student independent, self-monitored work. By increasing technology skills and using computer-assisted learning, students become more responsible for their own learning. If the Arts & Motion Program is used as a Summer Program or Afterschool Program, or as a remedial care program such as Title I, the Learning Pod could be used for review work. This program is also a useful enrichment program for Gifted and Talented students.

It is also one of our objectives that our students and families adopt good nutrition, healthy eating habits, and physical activity for sustaining healthy weights, preventing obesity, and reducing risk factors for obesityrelated chronic diseases.
